Induction, training and public awareness

- 1 All role players involved will be briefed on the Emergency Response Plan, Security Plan, Emergency Medical Plan, Evacuation Plan and Traffic Flow Plan on Friday, at the Clubhouse
- 3 Public will not be given access to the airside. FABS has permanent fencing in place to separate public areas from the airside.

Venue Operations Centre

The VOC will be located at the TOWER

EMERGENCIES

Aircraft incident on airport.

Duties of Event Director

- 1 Raise alarm and inform Fire Tender by radio
- 2 Decide if event must be stopped

- 3 If event to be stopped, will aircraft still flying be diverted to alternate or land back at FABS
- 4 Inform Safety Officer
5. If event continues, inform Safety Officer.

Duties of the Safety Officer.

- 1 Raise alarm and inform Fire Tender by radio
- 2 Inform event director
- 3 Activate VOC, if necessary
- 4 If event to be stopped, inform ATC and, if necessary, to divert all traffic to alternate airports.
- 5 If event to continue, inform ATC to advise all traffic of situation and alternate measures for circuit, approach and landing.
- 6 Co-ordinate all airside movement with ATC.
- 7 Co-ordinate access and egress of emergency vehicles.

Duties of the Air Traffic Controller

- 1 Supply grid reference (or position) of accident scene
- 2 inform Event Director, Safety Officer and Emergency Manager by radio
- 3 Divert aircraft in the air to Airport, if necessary
- 4 Control all vehicle movement on airside.
- 5 Activate SACAA Accident team (or advise SACAA on duty accident official by telephone), if necessary.

Duties of Emergency Manager

- 1 Take control of the emergency until VOC is active.
- 2 Determine resources required and activate them.
- 3 Determine if additional resources are required and activate.
- 4 Establish rendezvous point at VOC.

Duties of Fire Services

- 1 Turn out to scene.
- 2 Perform firefighting, rescue and patient care duties.
- 3 Establish and man the forward command post.
- 4 Declare scene safe for other roll players to enter.

Duties of Emergency Medical Services

- 1 Report to forward control point.
- 2 Establish and man the care area.
- 3 Treat patients.
- 4 Establish and identify the transportation area.

Duties of Additional Resources Arriving from

- 1 Report to rendezvous point.
- 2 Follow instructions from Emergency Manager.

Duties of the Venue Operations Centre

- 1 As described in Safety at Sports and Recreation Events act, 2010.
- 2 Once scene has been cleared, the decision whether to continue with the event or not must be taken by VOC.

Duties of Public Announcer (if on site)

- 1 If it is required to evacuate the public, inform them of this.
- 2 Inform public to inform officials if there is any one requiring medical assistance.

Duties of Security Guards and Event Marshals

- 1 If required, assist with public evacuation to main entrance.

Duties of SAPS

- 1 Cordon off and safe guard accident scene.

- 2 Activate required Police divisions for accident, i.e. Mortuary etc.

Fire Emergency on Airport

Potential risks

- 1 Fire in public parking area
- 2 Aircraft fire on flight line
- 3 Fire at refueling depot
- 4 Grass fire on airport.

The location and nature of the fire will determine the actions required by various emergency services, whether or not public must be evacuated and whether or not the event must be stopped.
