HOW WILL THE UPCOMING MANDATE FROM THE SACAA REGARDING LEGISLATED TRANSPONDER MODULES IMPACT YOU?

To operate in Class A and Class C Airspace, all LSA aircraft will need to be equipped with Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) and Mode Select (Mode-S) Transponders.

Dean spearheaded the initial installation and testing of ADS-B transponder technology for consumer drones in South Africa. He will share his extensive expertise on this subject on March 8th at Airweek, followed by a Q&A session. Additionally, Dean will showcase a variety of ADS-B technology for LSA, available for display and purchase.

Dean Polley is the director of SSASS Holdings, serving as the reseller for US-based uAvionix Corporation in Africa.
